SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES & FACILITIES

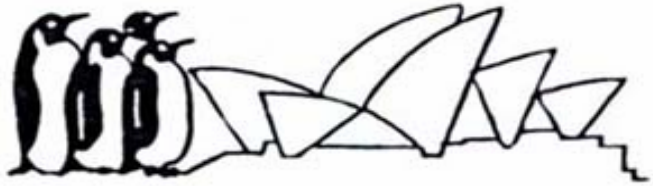
We issue our magazine ‘*Penguin Views*’ **three times annually.**

We invite you to participate and benefit from all its activities.



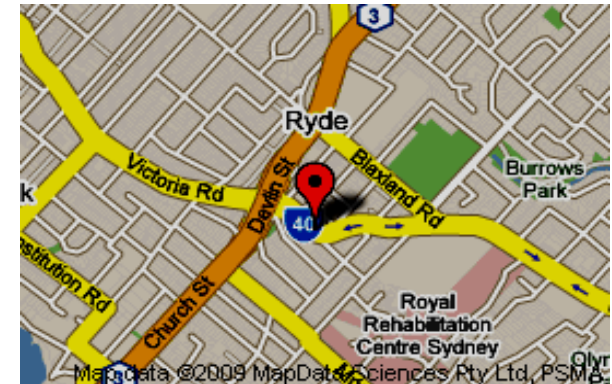
